HOW MANY There is room for 8 artists, allowing each to use one 4' x 8' display panel.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

SETUP Thursday, May 1, between 10am and 11am. Bring a hammer, nails, pushpins if you have them, and a step stool if you have one (at least 2-3 steps).

TAKE-DOWN Saturday, May 31, between 10am and 11am. Work cannot be left at the venue for later pick up.

SALES TRANSACTIONS All transactions are handled by EPCC. Proceeds from sold work will be paid to you when you pick up your work at the end of show. If an artist prefers to collect sales transaction prior to end of show, the artist is required to sign off for it at EPCC.

SOLD WORK: If a buyer requests to take their purchased artwork prior to end of show, the artist will be contacted and given an opportunity to replace sold work with another piece(s). The intent is to avoid empty display spaces in the show.

ARTIST INFORMATION: Artists are encouraged to include their business cards with work. Contact information will allow potential customers to contact artist if they wish to purchase additional works.

FEES A nonrefundable \$5 fee for entering the show is payable through our website, using the Donations link.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- Artwork should be framed or matted, unless the work is on gallery-wrapped canvas (stretched around to the back of the stretcher bars and stapled in the back).
- There must be wire mounting on the back or hanging hooks on back (there is no hardware available at site to assemble wire mounting on frames)
- No wet paint (wet oils).
- Artwork of nudes is not allowed for this exhibit
- Either price your work or label it NFS (not for sale).
- Work must be original (not a class follow-along, a direct copy of a copyrighted image, or a copy of another artist's work).
- No reproductions are allowed. If you want to sell prints of your work you may state that in your Artist Bio along with your contact information.
