PAG MEMBER SHOW
at East Portland Community Center (EPCC)

When: EPCC runs a PAG Art Show annually in May and November
Where: East Portland Community Center; 740 SE 106th Ave Portland, OR 97216
Who: Limited to **PAG Members** of all skill levels
How Many: There is room for 8 artists. Each artist is allowed a 4'X8' panel to display work

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

SETUP 1st of the May/November between the hours of 10am and 11am. Bring supplies to hang work (hammer, nails, pushpins, leveler, and step ladder/stool (should have at least 2-3 steps))

TAKE-DOWN Last day of May/November between the hours of 10am and 11am. Work cannot be left at the venue. If you are unable to attend the assigned setup and take-down days have a proxy do the setup and takedown for you.

SALES TRANSACTIONS All transactions are handled by EPCC. Proceeds from sold work will be distributed to artist at end of the show. The artist is required to sign off for all sold work with EPCC.

SOLD WORK If a buyer requests to take their purchased piece prior to end of the show, the artist will be contacted and given an opportunity to replace sold work with another piece. The intent is to avoid empty display wall space.

ARTIST INFORMATION Artists are encouraged to include contact information (email/website) on their bio write-up. Contact information will allow potential customers to contact artist if they wish to purchase additional work.

FEES A nonrefundable \$5 fee for entering the show is payable using the *Donations* link on PAG's website.

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- Artworks should be framed or matted, unless the work is on gallery-wrapped canvas (stretched around to the back of the stretcher bars and stapled in the back).
- There must be wire mounting on the back or hanging hooks on back (there is no hardware available at site to assemble wire mounting on frames).
- No wet paint (wet oils).
- Artwork of nudes is not allowed.
- Price all work or label it NFS if work is not for sale.
- Work must be original (not a class follow-along, a direct copy of a copyrighted image, or a copy of another artist's work).
- No reproductions are allowed. If you want to sell prints of your work you may state that in your artist bio.
