WHEN: Exhibits runs the month of **May 2026**

WHERE: East Portland Community Center 740 SE 106th Ave, Portland, OR 97216

WHO: Portland Photography Meetup Members of all skill levels

HOW MANY PARTICIPANTS? Ideally there is room for 8 artists, allowing each person one 4' X 8' display panel. We can double up on boards if more than 8 sign up. Priority is given to members who have not participated in the past.

Here's what you need to know:

1. **Deadline to submit materials to participate in May art show:** **Tuesday, April 2**
2. **Submission forms** are found on PAG website on the Events page. Fill out the form called Artwork List. Further directions are found on the form. <https://portlandartguild.org/events/>
3. **Set-up Date:** **Friday, May 1** between **10am and 11am**.
4. **Take-down Date:** **Sunday, May 31** You must pick up your work between **10am -11am**. Work cannot be left at the venue for later pick up. *If you cannot comply with the scheduled times and dates to set-up or take-down artwork, contact James Clark @ EPCC (503) 823-3450 or at James.Clarke@portlandoregon.gov*
5. **Materials to set up work:** Bring your own hammer, nails, step stools (at least 2-3 steps).
6. **Sale transactions:** Sold work will be paid at end of show. If artist prefers to collect sales transaction prior to end of show, the artist is required to sign off for it at EPCC.
7. **Sold work:** If a buyer requests to take sold work prior to end of show, the artist shall be contacted for an opportunity to replace sold work with another piece(s). The intent is to avoid empty display spaces in the show.
8. **Artist Information:** Artists are encouraged to include their business cards with displayed work. It is common for customers to want to talk to artist or to consign work.
9. **Note:** The show ends on **May 31**. Sale transactions can be collected a week after the show if you have plans to be away the last day of the show. All transactions are handled by the East Portland Community Center.

Art Requirements:

****Work that is not prepared as noted below will not be accepted.****

1. Work shall be framed or matted. However, framing isn't needed if the canvas is gallery wrapped (stretched around to the back of the stretcher bars).
2. All work must be ready to hang with mounting wire or hanging hooks on back – *there is no hardware available at the site to assemble wire mounting on frames.*
3. No wet paint.
4. Artwork of nudes is not allowed.
5. Price all art work for sale, or label it at NFS (not for sale).
6. Artist shall provide a short artist bio statement about self and artwork.
7. Labels are required for each artwork. These labels shall include artist name, title of work, medium used, and price.
8. The number of pieces per artist is dependent upon the number of artists taking place and the size of works. How many of your pieces will fit on a 4' X 8' display panel?
9. Work must be original (not a class follow-along, a direct copy of a copyrighted image, or copy of another artist's work).
